**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE
ROBINHOOD ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City has plans to construct a sidewalk Robinhood Road from the Muddy Creek Greenway parking lot to Speaks Farm Road; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of this project is \$607,084; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2016, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Advisory Committee approved the use of \$485,667 in Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funds for this project; and

WHEREAS, federal STBG-DA funds require a 20% local match; therefore, the City is required to provide \$121,417 in local matching funds; and

WHEREAS, this resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT), whereby the City will design and construct the project and NCDOT will reimburse the city for all eligible project expenses, up to \$485,667; and

WHEREAS, the City's local match of \$121,417 is available from 2014 Bond Funds, which are already appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem will allow the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Robinhood Road Sidewalk Project.
