

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PERMISSION TO APPLY FOR A TWELFTH YEAR OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NORTH CAROLINA GOVERNOR'S HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAM FOR TO SUPPORT CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE FORSYTH COUNTY DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED (DWI) TASK FORCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Winston-Salem (CITY), Forsyth County (COUNTY) and the Town of Kernersville (TOWN) have the opportunity to apply for continued funding under a grant from the North Carolina Governor's Highway Safety Program (GHSP) to continue operation of the Forsyth County DWI Joint Task Force; and

**WHEREAS**, this potential opportunity of continued funding will require the submission of a grant application of which the CITY will be the primary applicant on behalf of all three participating agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the maximum funding by GHSP is 25% of personnel and travel expenses during this twelfth year of operation, with the remaining 75% of expenses to be provided as a cash match from all three participating agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant will provide continued partial funding for salaries and benefits of three officers and one sergeant from the Winston-Salem Police Department, one deputy from the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office, and one officer from the Kernersville Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Task Force will continue to be responsible for enhanced enforcement of laws prohibiting driving while intoxicated and other responsibilities and activities as outlined in the grant application; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize permission to apply for a twelfth year of grant funding
