Resolution Authorizing A Change Order To Sports Court Solutions By Floor Action, Inc. In The Amount Of \$18,176 For The Gymnasium Floor Improvements At Hanes Hosiery Community Center (North Ward)

**Summary of Information:**

On January 11, 2021, the Recreation and Parks Department entered into an agreement with Sports Court Solutions by Floor Action, Inc. for \$399,950.00 for the replacement of five indoor basketball courts at Sprague Street, Miller, W.C. Sims, and Martin Luther King Jr., Community Centers.

Construction and installation of all wood gymnasium floors are complete. Hanes Hosiery Community Center is the home of many tournaments, league basketball play, and host to a variety of community events. In April 2018, the gymnasium was named in honor of Art Blevins, former Recreation Center Supervisor. The gymnasium floor will be replaced with a custom design that represents and honors the contributions Mr. Blevins made to the community. To cover the cost of this additional work, a change order is requested to the contract with Sports Court Solutions by Floor Action, Inc. The change order is not to exceed the amount of \$18,176.00, bringing the total contract value to \$517,413.50. There are existing savings from the gym floor renovations to cover the cost of the change order.
