RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2025 SECTION 5307 JOB ACCESS AND REVERSE COMMUTE AND FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2020 SECTION 5307 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANT AWARDS FOR ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Area Transportation Planning Organization (WSATPO) is a direct recipient of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the program provides available federal resources to eligible agencies to assist with meeting the transportation needs of low-income populations to get to education and work opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the WSATPO held a 30-day call for projects between June 2, 2025, and July 2, 2025, and conducted an applicant workshop on June 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the WSATPO coordinated an external review of three submitted proposals for Section 5307 funding by the Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, this process is based on the Federal Circulars for this program and is incorporated in the Program Management Plan, Coordinated Public Transit Human Services Transportation Plan and the City's Allocation Policy for review of applications; and

WHEREAS, during the grants review process, an additional unspent amount of \$45,076 was identified from FY 2020 American Rescue Plan Act and these funds were made available and allocated to eligible applicants during this call making the full funding allocation \$100,076 for Section 5307 JARC; and

WHEREAS, the WSATPO has recommended, and the Transportation Advisory

Committee has approved the funding distribution to each eligible sub-recipient as shown on

Attachment A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize the City Manager to execute contracts with the approved agencies for the Section 5307 Job Access Reverse Commute and American Rescue Plan Act funds.
