**Council Action Requested:**

Adoption of Resolutions Authorizing Municipal Agreements with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Maintenance of traffic control signs, markings, signals and computerized traffic signal system.

**Summary of Information:**

The City of Winston-Salem currently installs and maintains traffic control devices on state maintained roadways under a municipal maintenance agreement.

Schedule A defines the rate at which the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will reimburse the City for maintenance of signs on state roads within the municipal limits. Schedule B defines the rate at which NCDOT will reimburse the City for maintenance of pavement markings and markers on state roads within the municipal limits. Schedule C defines the rate at which NCDOT will reimburse the City for maintenance of state signals within the municipal limits. Schedule D defines the rate at which NCDOT will reimburse the City for maintenance and operation of the computerized traffic signal system. The revised contracts submitted for Schedules A, B, C, and D include adjustments to the reimbursement rates. Costs for materials to be furnished and installed under the maintenance agreement have been adjusted to reflect current state contract prices.

The municipal maintenance expenditures and reimbursements are included in the existing budget for Traffic Systems Maintenance.
