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**RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER  
FOR ONE SIDE LOADING REFUSE TRUCK**

**WHEREAS**, the Refuse Division of the Sanitation Department is requesting to purchase a side loading refuse truck as a replacement for a vehicle that meets or exceeds Fleet's replacement criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, the North Carolina Department of Administration received bids for fleet vehicles and on May 10, 2021, Piedmont Truck Center (Greensboro, NC) was awarded competitive bid contract #070A; and

**WHEREAS**, Piedmont Truck Center has offered a quotation for a 2024 Ford F-450 chassis with Martco Pak-Rat side loading refuse collection body at a total cost of \$125,370.30; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sanitation Department requests that a purchase order be awarded to Piedmont Truck Center for a 2024 Ford F-450 chassis with Martco Pak-Rat side loading refuse collection body at a total cost of \$125,370.30. This recommendation is in accordance with N.C.G.S 143-129(e)(9), an exception to formal bidding which authorizes "The [bidding] requirements of this article do not apply to ... Purchases from contracts established by the State or any agency of the State, if the contractor is willing to extend the same or more favorable prices, terms, or conditions as established in the State contract".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon approval by the Finance Committee, that a purchase order is hereby awarded to Piedmont Truck Center in the total amount of \$125,370.30.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The company's offer, the NCDA

contract #070A bid specifications, and the City's purchase order will constitute the contract. The City is not legally bound until the purchase order is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this purchase is included in the FY 2023-24 capital equipment budget and will be financed through the City's internal leasing program.
