RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION AND INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, in 2019, the City of Winston-Salem entered into municipal agreements with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) for sidewalk construction and intersection improvements on Silas Creek Parkway from Bolton Street to Lockland Avenue (EB-5722); Barbara Jane Avenue from Old Greensboro Road to Woodrow Powell Drive (EB-5810); and Griffith Road from Burke Mill Rd to Kimwell Drive (EB-5955); and

WHEREAS, these projects were partially funded by federal Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA), with the City providing a 20% local match; and

WHEREAS, the construction estimates for these projects are 7-8 years old and after updating construction costs, from recently bid City and state projects, a budget deficit exists; and

WHEREAS, in February 2024 the City applied to the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization for available federal funding to cover the gap between the original estimate and current bid prices; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded additional federal funding for Silas Creek Parkway (EB-5722) in the amount of \$3,800,000; Barbara Jane Avenue (EB-5810) in the amount of \$368,000; and Griffith Road (EB-5955) in the amount of \$1,880,000; and

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for providing a 20% local match for this additional federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the City's local match of \$1,512,000 is available from 2018 GO Bonds and Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that the City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to enter into Supplemental

Agreements with NCDOT for additional funding for sidewalk construction and intersection improvements on Silas Creek Parkway, Barbara Jane Avenue, and Griffith Road.
