Rev. Hunter stated he runs the first community garden located on Dunlieth Avenue since 1994. Rev. Hunter voiced his concerns about agricultural farming and property that he and his wife purchased in East Winston at 1712 East 25th Street with the intent to plant a community garden. He proposed the question to Council to consider grandfathering particular vacant lots proposed for community gardens in Forsyth County as these individuals were not aware of new ordinances. Mayor Pro Tempore Burke expressed her appreciation for what Rev. Hunter has done in the community as well.

Martha Cecil, 2026 Creekwood Drive, Greensboro 27407

Stated that on April 25, 2017, Los Angeles, CA unanimously voted to ban wild animals in circuses. She requested that the Public Safety Committee consider placing an item to ban wild animal circuses back on its agenda for consideration.
