I have witnessed first hand the amount of traffic on Bethania Rd. I cannot imagine how Queens Grant would be a logical decision to connect with your planned development to Bethania Rd. The speeding on Bethania Rd is out of control. In the last 4 years, there has been 4 accidents on my property. All were related to speed, drugs and alcohol. The brick wall on the corner my property had been destroyed 2 times. All 4 of these accidents occurred during the night. I was the one who responded to each of these thinking I would find someone dead. One vehicle was on its side. I had to pull that person out of the vehicle. He was so intoxicated he could not stand. I have complained to the sheriff's department about the speeding. I cannot believe that this road can handle more traffic with the addition of this planned development.
