Summary of Information:				
The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from James Armentrout to close and abandon a portion of Friendship Church Road located off of Old Lexington Road. The area petitioned for closure is an unopened 16-foot wide right-of-way, located at the end of Friendship Church Road. It was believed to have previously been closed by NCDOT, but a remnant still remains. This right-of-way is approximately 55 feet in length. The area is bounded on the North & West by Tax PIN 6832-99-9790. It is bounded on the South by Tax PIN 6842-09-0428, and on the East by the rest of Friendship Church Road.				
The Public Works Department has reviewed the request. There are no Planning or Winston-Salem Department Of Transportation concerns if this right-of-way is closed. No property owner would be denied access to their property if this petition is approved. There are no public utilities located in this right-of-way. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.
