ON-STREET PARKING PROGRAM

1330 on-street parking spaces downtown

~550 metered spaces

~100 Spaces controlled by pay stations

Remaining spaces are time limited using signage.

No current use of use technology-based payment





Encourage the convenient shortterm use for patrons Encourage long-term parking customers to park in off-street parking facilities such as decks and lots.

GOALS - ON STREET PARKING



- ▶ Single space meters: \$0.25/hr.
- ▶ Time restrictions: 1-3 hours.

ON-STREET RATES

- ▶ Pay Stations: Tiered rate structure
 - ▶ \$0.25 for first hour,
 - ▶ \$10.00-Max (over 6 hr.)
- ► Customers choose the length of time desired, not limited by a maximum length of stay.
- Encourages short term parking.

PAY-BY-PHONE APPS

- ▶ Passport Parking and Park Mobile are the two providers used most often.
- ▶ Allow customers to pay fee using either a toll-free telephone number or a smart phone application.
- ▶ Additional fees associated with these services.

ADVANTAGES OF PAY-BY-PHONE APPS

- ▶Streamline Operations
- ▶ Ability to add time if needed- Improve User Experience
- Ability to integrate with other parking technologies
- ▶ Dashboard Data/Reporting
- ► Lower Maintenance Costs
- ▶Scalable

DISADVANTAGES OF PAY-BY-PHONE APPS

- ▶ Technology barrier
- ▶ Requires user to possess smart phone
- ► Apps require credentials (create a login)

UPGRADING CURRENT PARKING EQUIPMENT

▶ Pay stations can accept cash, coin, credit card, and mobile parking app payments

▶ New pay stations cost: ~ \$18,000.

▶ Existing single space meters are not capable of accepting credit card payments. The cost to replace a single space meter with a modern single space meter is about \$1,250 per meter with a monthly service fee of \$5.00 and a credit card processing fee.

WHAT'S BEEN DONE?

- 1. Council Approved Rate Increase (2018)
- 2. Council Authorized Parking Meter Upgrades (2021)
- 3. Budget appropriations for parking systems analysis RFQ

WHAT'S DOT DOING?

- 1. RFQ-Parking Systems Analysis
 - Modernize parking systems and equipment
 - Provide guidance on systems integration
 - February 2023 Award
- 2. Purchased new Single Space Parking Meter Equipment
 - Programable coin mechanisms which allows for rate increase
 - Delivered Summer 2022
 - Roll out 2023 (\$0.50/hr)
