PETITION TO CLOSE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF DEACON BOULEVARD

FORSYTH COUNTY)

TO: HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM

The undersigned respectfully petitions the Honorable Mayor and City Council of the City

of Winston-Salem as follows:

I.

Your petitioners declare that they each own one or more parcels of that real property described on the attached <u>Schedule I</u>, and that, except for the real property described on <u>Schedule I</u>, there is no other real property abutting the portion of the right-of-way of Deacon Boulevard, and the associated underground pedestrian tunnel, which the petitioners want to have closed and abandoned.

Please state your reason / purpose for closing a portion of said street / alleyway: This street closure and underground pedestrian tunnel closure are being requested in connection with a plan to reroute a portion of Deacon Boulevard, which new route, upon completion of construction and connection of such new route with the remaining existing right-of-way of Deacon Boulevard, will render unnecessary the portion of Deacon Boulevard that is the subject of this petition (the "Subject Portion of Deacon Boulevard") as well as the pedestrian tunnel running beneath it (the "Subject Tunnel"), which tunnel is subject to that Right of Way Encroachment and Tunnel Access Agreement dated July 31, 2013 by and between the City of Winston-Salem and Wake Forest University, being recorded in Book 3138, Page 2564 in the Forsyth County Registry (the "Tunnel Agreement").

The Subject Portion of Deacon Boulevard was dedicated to public use upon the public records appearing in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Forsyth County, North Carolina. Pursuant to the Tunnel Agreement, the Subject Tunnel is used for public purposes in connection with events at the nearby Coliseum and City Fairgrounds. Upon completion of construction of the re-routed portion of Deacon Street Closing Petition

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Boulevard, and connection of such new portion with the remaining existing right-of-way of Deacon Boulevard, the use of the Subject Portion of Deacon Boulevard as a street or public way, and the use of the Subject Tunnel as a pedestrian passageway, will be unnecessary for the normal flow of traffic through the surrounding area.

II.

Your petitioners respectfully petition that the following described portion of said Deacon Boulevard and the Subject Tunnel officially be closed and abandoned, and that the Tunnel Agreement be terminated by the parties: (insert property description of the property listed above)

No individual owning property in the vicinity of the Subject Portion of Deacon Boulevard or the Subject Tunnel will be deprived of reasonable means of ingress to and from his property, nor is the closing thereof contrary to the public interest.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully request the City of Winston-Salem, acting through its City Council, to close and abandon for street purposes that portion of said Deacon Boulevard described and the Subject Tunnel described in the Tunnel Agreement, all as provided by law, particularly by Section 160A-299 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
