**Summary of Information:**

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from John Shipley to close and abandon a portion of Torrance Drive. The area petitioned for closure is an unopened 40-foot platted right-of-way that extends north of Stanton Drive and is approximately 369 feet in length. It is bounded on the north by Tax PIN's 6817-41-2244, and 6817-41-4105, on the east by Tax PIN's 6817-41-4105, and 6817-40-4908, and on the west by Tax PIN's 6817-40-2836, and 6817-41-1014.

The Public Works Department has reviewed the request. There are no Planning or WSDOT concerns if this right-of-way is closed. There are no public utilities located in this right-of-way, with which the City would need to retain easements. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.
