Summary of Information

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition to close and abandon an unopened portion of Fenimore Street. The area petitioned for closure is an unopened public right of way containing approximately 2,226 sq ft. It is bounded on the north and east by Tax PIN 6824-47-6285, and on the west by Tax PIN 6824-47-3320.

City Staff has reviewed the request. There are no Planning or WSDOT concerns if this portion of right-of-way is closed. There are no public utilities located in the right-of-way petitioned for closure and the City would not need to retain easements. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.
