BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contract is duly executed by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Dalton Contracting, LLC will be required to subcontract, at a minimum, 18.6% of this contract with certified minority-owned businesses and 45.8% with certified women-owned businesses as indicated on the Affidavit "C" submitted by the company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds have been previously appropriated and made available in the 2018 G.O. Bond to cover the cost of this contract.
