Summary of Information:

Bids were received August 27, 2018, for the purchase of 26 Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles, intended as scheduled replacements. See exhibit A for replacement information. Below is a summary of bids received:

On October 3, 2017, the North Carolina Sheriff’s Association, a cooperative purchasing group located in Raleigh, N.C., awarded contracts for police pursuit vehicles and Performance Automotive Group, Inc. was awarded competitive bid contract #18-04-0912 per bid specifications. Performance Automotive Group, Inc. has offered a quotation for 26 model year 2019 Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles at a cost of \$21,985 each for a total cost of \$571,610.

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes “purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies.”
