Historic Resources staff has reviewed the four properties that are scheduled to go before the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee on June 9, 2025 for demolition consideration. Per the list provided by Neighborhood Services, the proposed demolitions are:

1. 1405 E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street – Northeast Ward
2. 1526 E. 25<sup>th</sup> Street -Northeast Ward
3. 1508 E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street – Northeast Ward
4. 1515 E. 21<sup>st</sup> Street - Northeast Ward

Currently, the buildings are not designated Local Historic Landmarks nor located within a locally designated historic district nor have been designated to the National Register of Historic Places. Therefore, there are no recommendations for these structures currently.
