Resolution Awarding Contract for Concrete Streets Replacement (West Ward)

**Summary of Information:**

The City has several streets that were built with concrete having substandard curbs and gutters. Subsequent resurfacing with asphalt has left them with inadequate gutters to drain stormwater and the thin layer of surface asphalt is continually eroding. The proposed work includes the removal of the existing concrete and asphalt pavement, drainage improvements, utility improvements, and the installation of a new asphalt, and curb and gutter. This project will rehabilitate five streets listed below:

- Arbor Road - From Robinhood Road to County Club Road
- Biting Road - From Club Park Road to Westview Drive
- Fairfax Drive - From Windsor Road to dead end
- Lynn Avenue - From Windsor Road to Greenwich Road
- Windsor Road - From Plymouth Avenue to Fairfax Drive

The City advertised bids for the Concrete Streets Replacement project, a 2018 G.O. Bond project, with bid opening Tuesday, April 27, 2021. Below is a summary of bids offered:

**Remarks:**

Sharpe Bros., A Division of Vecellio & Grogan, Inc. has agreed to the goals established for this project of 6% with minority owned businesses and 4% with women owned businesses; therefore, it is recommended that a contract for the Concrete Streets Replacement project per bid specifications be awarded to Sharpe Bros., A Division of Vecellio & Grogan, Inc., the low bidder meeting specifications, in the estimated amount of \$4,396,253.46.

M/WBE comment: This project was advertised on the City and HUB websites, with several electronic plan rooms, and 21 contractors were notified directly of this opportunity. Notifications were also sent to all local M/WBE and regional HUB and DBE businesses.
