Resolution Awarding Contract for Concrete Streets Replacement (West Ward)

## **Summary of Information:**

The City has several streets that were built with concrete having substandard curbs and gutters. Subsequent resurfacing with asphalt has left them with inadequate gutters to drain stormwater and the thin layer of surface asphalt is continually eroding. The proposed work includes the removal of the existing concrete and asphalt pavement, drainage improvements, utility improvements, and the installation of a new asphalt, and curb and gutter. This project will rehabilitate five streets listed below:

- Arbor Road From Robinhood Road to County Club Road
- Bitting Road From Club Park Road to Westview Drive
- Fairfax Drive From Windsor Road to dead end
- Lynn Avenue From Windsor Road to Greenwich Road
- Windsor Road From Plymouth Avenue to Fairfax Drive

The City advertised bids for the Concrete Streets Replacement project, a 2018 G.O. Bond project, with bid opening Tuesday, April 27, 2021. Below is a summary of bids offered:
