

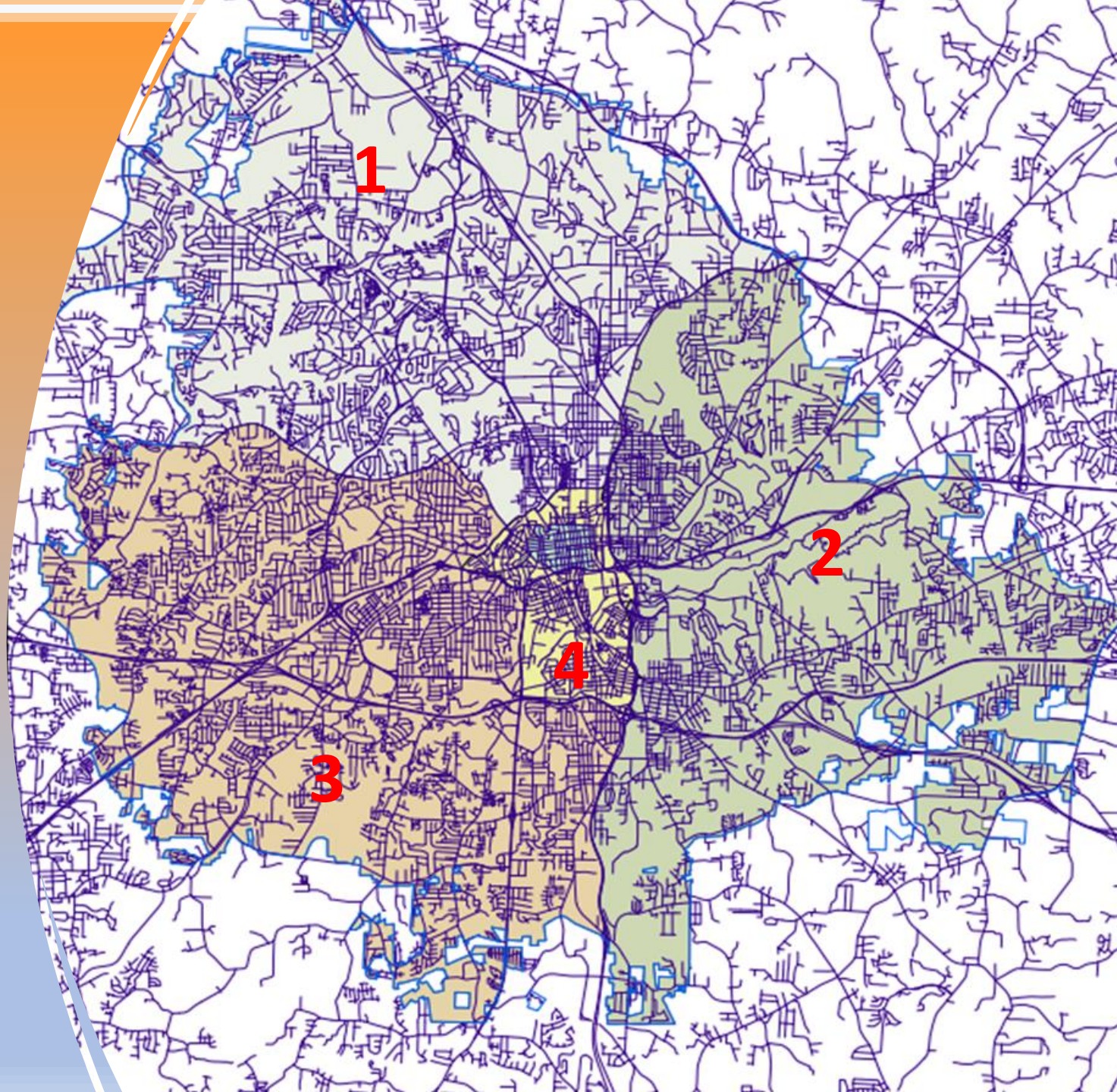

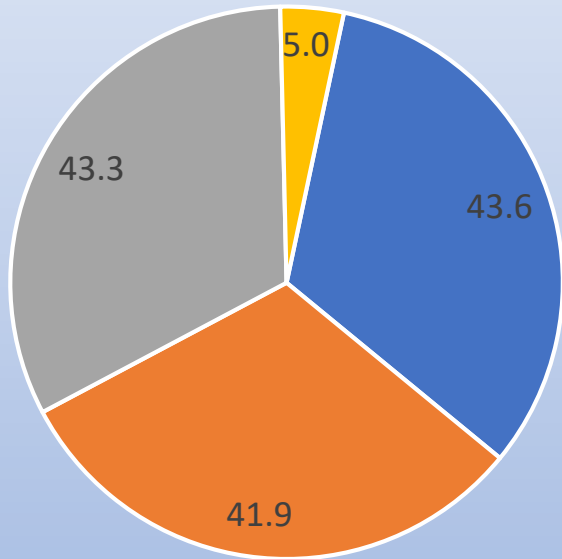

Overall view of the proposed District 4 as it falls within the city as a whole

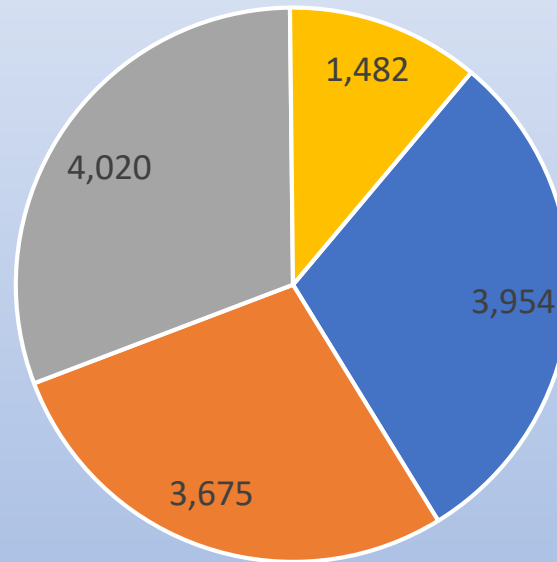


# District Size and Calls for Service

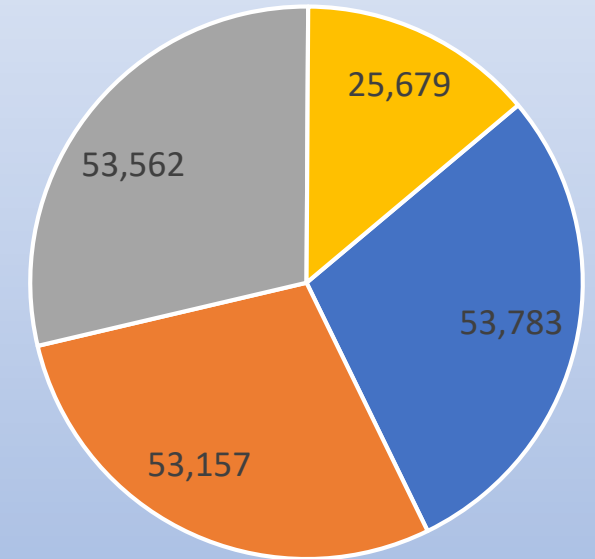
Square Mileage by District

■ District 1 ■ District 2 ■ District 3 ■ District 4

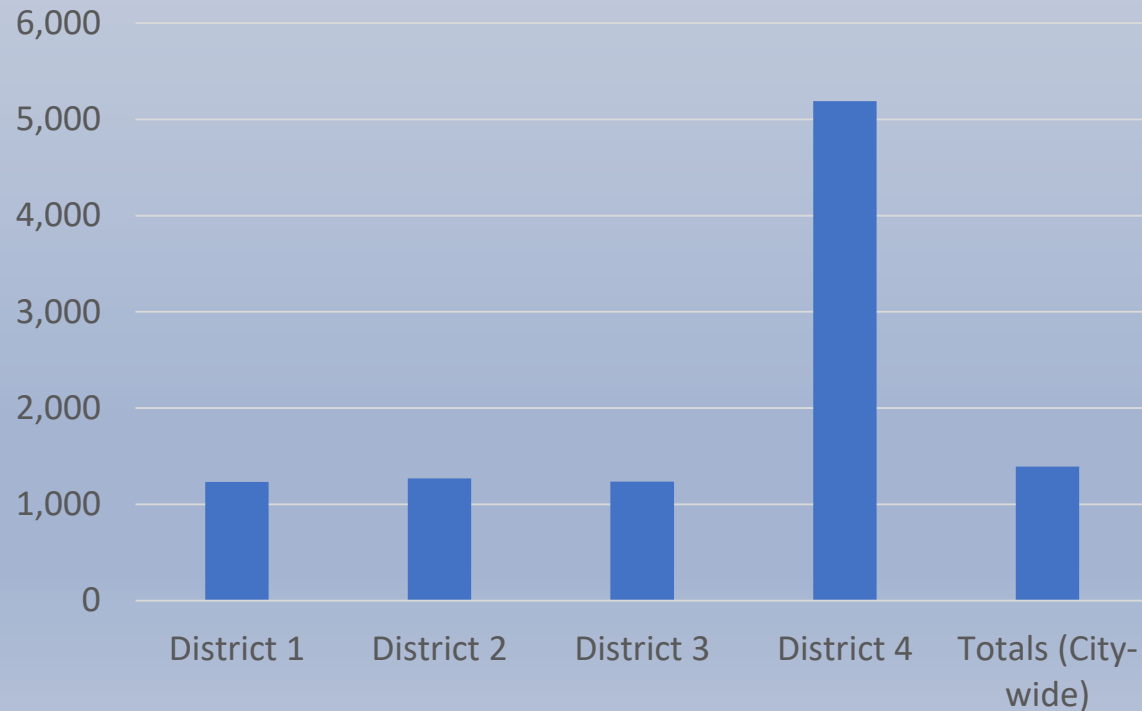
The new District 4 represents 4% of the City's total footprint but generates 11% of Part 1 Crimes and 14% of all calls for service city-wide.

# Comparative Data on Calls for Service

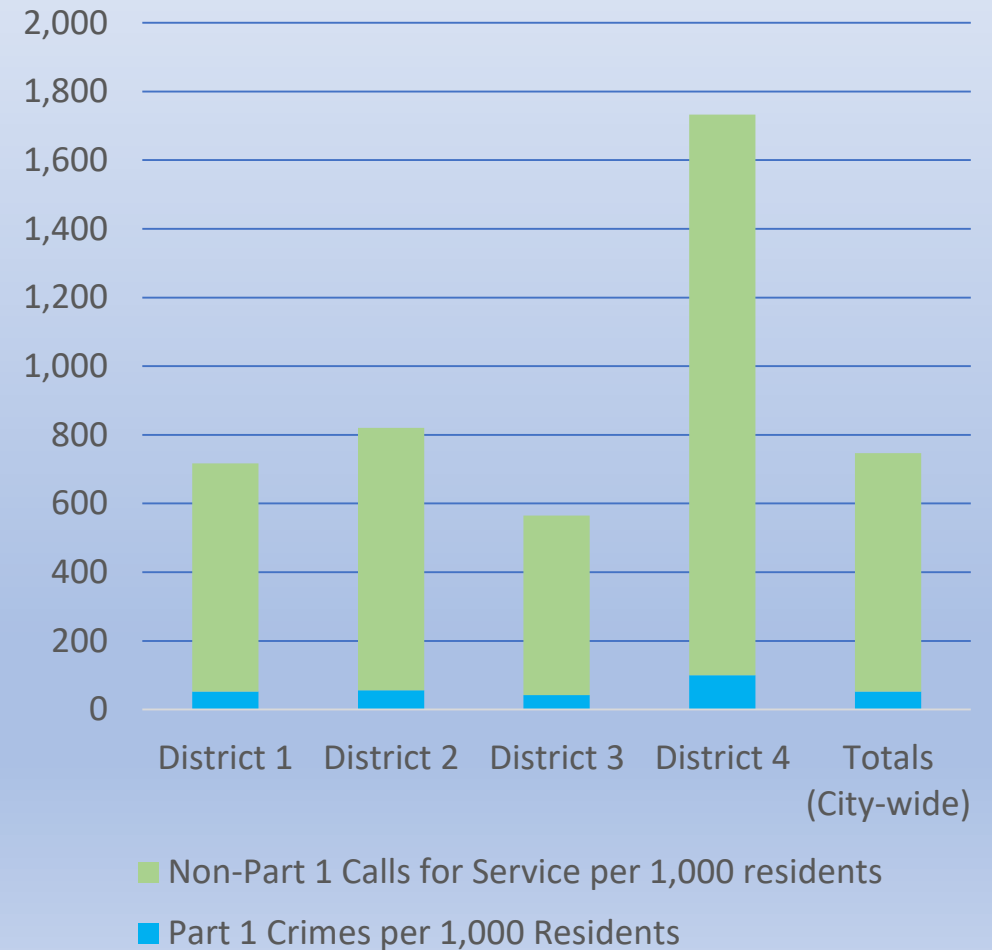
**Calls for Service per Square Mile:** Total calls for service per square mile in District 4 are four times higher than any other district.

**Crime Rate:** Total calls for service per capita in District 4 are more than double any other district.

# Staffing Numbers

- The number of patrol officers citywide will not change with the implementation of a new district. Restructuring to add a 4<sup>th</sup> district will reorganize resources with more similar call types and constituent concerns to provide more efficient service and potentially reduce travel/response times to non-emergency calls.
- We currently have 4 platoons (2-day shift platoons and 2-night shift platoons).
- There are approximately 51 officers per platoon.
