

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE  
FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION FISCAL YEAR 2026 SECTION 5307 FORMULA  
FUNDING SUB-ALLOCATION OR SPLIT LETTER FOR  
DAVIDSON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) FY 2026 Section 5307 Formula funds are appropriated to urban areas with more than 200,000 in population; and

**WHEREAS**, the Winston-Salem Urban area receives a full appropriation of the FY 2026 Section 5307 Formula funding in the amount of \$7,042,301; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Winston-Salem is the designated recipient of this funding for the Winston-Salem Urban Area; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds are sub-allocated to three transit agencies serving the Transportation Planning Organization's urban area: Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA), Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) and Davidson County Transportation) and for Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) subrecipients; and

**WHEREAS**, WSTA receives \$6,025,150, PART receives \$688,948, Davidson County Transportation receives \$272,505, and JARC agencies receive \$55,000; and

**WHEREAS**, as a current direct recipient of FTA funding, Davidson County Transportation is eligible to apply directly to FTA for their portion of the FY 2026 Section 5307 Formula funds provided the City of Winston-Salem issues a sub-allocation or split letter; and

**WHEREAS**, the sub-allocation letter indicates to FTA that the direct recipient, Davidson County Transportation, will apply for the funding separately and release oversight responsibilities of fund administration from the designated recipient, or City of Winston-Salem; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends issuing a split letter to Davidson County Transportation for the FY 2026 Section 5307 Formula funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorizes the City Manager and City Clerk to execute a sub-allocation letter with Davidson County Transportation for FY 2026 Section 5307 Formula funds totaling \$272,505.
