DUE PROCESS

1. The current **Complaint and Notice of Hearing** was issued 03/10/2014 and service was obtained by certified mail x regular x post x hand delivery____, and publication____ on 03/17/2014. The Hearing was held on 4/9/2014 and the owner/agent appeared and/or contacted the Community Development Department regarding the complaint yes____ no x.
2. The **Finding and Order** was issued on 6/11/2014 and service was obtained by certified x regular x post x hand delivery____, and publication ____ on 06/21/2014. The Order directed the owner to **vacate and close or repair** the dwelling within 30 days from receipt. Time for compliance expired on 07/21/2014. The dwelling was found vacated and closed on 09/30/2014.
3. The dwelling became eligible for demolition under the six (6) month rule on 03/30/2015.
4. The notification letter was sent 05/10/2017 advising the owner that the **Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee** of the City Council would be considering demolition of this dwelling at their meeting on 06/13/2017. The notice further advised that if they intended to request an extension of time, they should present evidence of their intent to the Community Development Director prior to the Committee meeting. Director was contacted yes____ no x.

COUNCIL CONSIDERATION

The estimated cost to make repairs to needed to render this dwelling fit for human habitation is **less than fifty percent (<50%)** of the present value of the dwelling.

Estimated cost to repair \$4,756.00 Fair market value \$9,000.00

Based on the above information it is recommended that an Ordinance be adopted to cause this dwelling to be **repaired or demolished and removed within ninety (90) days. This structure can be repaired under In Rem provisions of the Minimum Housing Code with City Council approval.**
