**RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDITIONAL ITEMS RELATED TO THE
STROLLWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT TO SPEND THE REMAINING
PROJECT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the 2018 Bond Referendum allocated one million dollars for repairs on the Strollway between Salem Avenue and approximately 500' north of Brookstown Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the base scope of the project was pavement rehabilitation and bridge repair;
and

WHEREAS, total project expenditures to date are below the allocated amount; and

WHEREAS, a balance of approximately \$400,000 is available for additional improvements; and

WHEREAS, staff has compiled a list of additional items for consideration to spend the balance of available funds for the project; and

WHEREAS, the list consists of the following additional items:

- design and construct pedestrian signals at Marshall St/Salem Ave,
- design and construct pedestrian signals at Main St/Waughtown St,
- install pedestrian lighting on Molly Leight Bridge,
- install additional amenities such as bike racks and benches along the north side of Salem Avenue,
- widen sidewalk to 10' from crosswalk on west side of roundabout to the greenway access on west side of Main Street,
- and widen and install missing sidewalk on the north side of Alder Street from Waughtown Street to Happy Hill Park; and,

WHEREAS, this resolution will authorize staff to pursue projects to design and construct these additional items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon recommendation of the Assistant City Manager for Public Works and the City Manager, that the aforementioned list of additional project items be approved, authorizing staff to pursue projects to design and construct these additional items.
