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RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR ROAD SALT

WHEREAS, after due advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by the Purchasing Department at 10:00 a.m. on September 2, 2021, for an estimated 2,000 tons of road salt for use by the Department of Transportations' Streets Division to be ordered as needed during the period from November 1, 2021 through October 31, 2022 only the following bid was offered:

The Detroit Salt Company, LLC Detroit, MI \$120.23 240,460

WHEREAS, terms of the bid reserves the right to extend the contract for as many as four additional twelve month terms with the opportunity to adjust the cost per ton by an amount not to exceed the Producer Price Index if both parties agree, and funds are made available for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a contract be awarded to The Detroit Salt Company, LLC for an estimated 2,000 tons of road salt at a unit cost of \$120.23 per ton for a total amount of \$240,460 with the option to extend for as many as four additional twelve month terms if both parties agree, and funds are made available making the total possible award over five years in the estimated amount of \$1,202,300.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that the contract for an estimated 2,000 tons of road salt to be ordered as needed from November 1, 2021 through October 31, 2022, is hereby awarded to The Detroit Salt Company, LLC for an estimated 2,000 tons of road salt at a unit cost of \$120.23 per ton for a total amount of \$240,460 with the option to extend for as many as four additional twelve month

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terms if both parties agree, and funds are made available making the total possible award over five years in the estimated amount of \$1,202,300, and that the City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, contract forms to be approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualification of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contract is duly executed by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds have been appropriated in the FY 2021-22 budget to cover the cost of this purchase through June 30, 2022, with purchases thereafter subject to future budget appropriations.
