Summary of Information:
 The Community Sustainability Program Committee (CSPC) is seeking approval of the attached Resolution Urging the United States Congress to Enact the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act of 2021 (H.R. 2307).

The purpose of this resolution is to voice support of the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act. If passed by Congress, this act would establish a national carbon fee on fossil fuels to mitigate the effects of climate change.

CSPC members reviewed the resolution upon request of City Council Members due to growing interest from residents. The CSPC approved this resolution in the April 7 meeting as it was originally presented to them.
