- 2015 - 2017

 - Additional card readers
 - Additional lighting
 - Improved vegetation maintenance
 - Continued review of security policies and infrastructure



BUSINESS PROTECTION SPECIALISTS (BPS)

- Purpose

 - Vandalism
 - Crime
 - Theft
 - Potential terrorist activities
 - Other threats
- Identify gaps
- Provide recommendations



BPS ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY

- Site visit to City facilities
 - Administrative Buildings
 - Utilities Facilities
 - Winston-Salem Transit Authority
 - Winston-Salem Fairgrounds and The Benton
 - Recreation Facilities
 - City Yard
 - Fire Stations
- Completed draft assessment in February 2019

- Video surveillance
- Access control
- City Police presence
- Measures implemented during improvement projects
