Summary of Information:				
In accordance with the City of Winston-Salem's Traffic Calming Policy, approved by the City Council in 2003 and modified in 2016, residents of the Reynolda Park Neighborhood formed a Traffic Calming Task Force and submitted a petition for traffic calming. The traffic calming plan calls for speed cushions placed at regular intervals along the roadway and one multi-way stop. The Reynolda Park Neighborhood residents have completed all the required steps outlined in the policy, therefore, the Department of Transportation recommends approval and construction of the plan at a cost of \$26,000. Funds are available in the Traffic Calming Projects account 304-533125-5497 that are already budgeted. The plan is attached.
