Resolution Awarding a Purchase Order for Breathing Apparatus Air Compressor

## **Summary of Information:**

The Winston-Salem Fire Department needs a Breathing Apparatus Air Compressor at Fire Station No. 3. The installation of the compressor will be used as a secondary means of filling self-contained breathing apparatus cylinders in the event that air resource one is out of service, and for large scale incidents. The unit will include storage cylinders, a compressor, a fill station, and air filtration.

The NPPGov's Intergovernment Agreement, cooperative purchasing group, entered into a MPA Agreement per RFP No. 1920 for Fire Fighter Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus Compressors between the League of Oregon Cities and Bauer Compressors, Inc. per authorized dealer, Sub-Aquatics Inc. d/b/a Safe Air Systems of Randleman, N.C. per order #SO-NC15016 for the compressor system at a cost of \$178,132.29.

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies."

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Sub-Aquatics, Inc. d/b/a Safe Air Systems for the purchase of a Breathing Apparatus Air Compressor at a cost of \$178,132.29. The purchase of this compressor was approved in the General Fund FY 2023-24 budget.
