RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER WITH WALTER ROBBS CALLAHAN & PIERCE ARCHITECTS, P.A. FOR A NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$382,116 FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF TRUIST STADIUM MLB UPGRADES AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES

WHEREAS, in June and August of 2022, the City Council awarded a contract with Walter Robbs Callahan & Pierce Architects, P.A. for \$589,696 for professional architectural services for the design for the Truist Stadium MLB upgrades, Winston-Salem Dash administrative offices, and outfield restrooms; and

WHEREAS, while working with Frank L. Blum Construction and the Winston-Salem Dash on the construction documents, there have been several revisions to the scope of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, these revisions include modifications to the batting cage area, relocation of the lower-level concessions, and changes to the administrative offices; and

**WHEREAS**, during value engineering discussions, it was suggested that the project be broken up into three phases to address MLB requirements first; and

**WHEREAS**, phase 1 is the MLB requirements, phase 2 is for the relocation of the lower-level concession area, and phase 3 is for the Winston-Salem Dash administrative offices and outfield restrooms; and

WHEREAS, the architect has submitted fees for the additional design work; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimate for phases 1 and 2 is \$207,866 and the estimate for phase 3 is \$174,250, for an overall total of \$382,116; and

**WHEREAS,** if the additional fees are approved, the design contract value will total \$971,812.
