**RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH AZTECA SYSTEMS, LLC FOR
SOFTWARE LICENSES AND MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, software from Azteca Systems, LLC is used by staff in several departments as the system of record and to support work order and asset management (AMS) operations and permitting and inspections (PLL) business processes; and

WHEREAS, the AMS and PLL solutions offer mobile capabilities for staff in the field and the on-line portal 'BuildIT' used by the public; and

WHEREAS, since the Azteca software was deployed in 2015, the City has purchased annually, at a cost of \$155,640, the renewal of licenses and maintenance and support services; and

WHEREAS, the existing contract's initial term was January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, with City Council approval for four one-year renewals; and

WHEREAS, the fifth and last year of the contract expired on December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Information Systems Department requested a proposal from Azteca Systems, LLC for the renewal of these services for one year with the option to renew annually for two additional years, with an annual cost of \$155,640 and a total three-year cost of \$466,920; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in the approved Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Information Systems operating budget for the first year of the contract; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City enter into an agreement with Azteca Systems, LLC for the purchase of licenses and software maintenance and support services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem authorize the City Manager to enter into a one-year contract with Azteca

Systems, LLC for licenses and software maintenance and consulting services for a total cost of \$155,640, with the option to renew annually for two additional years if approved funds are available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City.
