<i>Here 2 There Van Services Transportation services to those in need in the Winston Salem and Forsyth County area. These services are available 24 hours/ 7 days a week to senior citizens and the disabled.</i>	\$227,000.00	Staff recommends the requested amount
<i>The Shepherd Center Increasing transportation services for older adults with disabilities in the Winston Salem and Forsyth County service areas. The expanded services will address the increasing demand for transportation services for medical appointments and grocery shopping assistance.</i>	\$190,000.00	Staff recommends the requested amount
