RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A MURAL ON THE STROLLWAY BETWEEN FIRST STREET AND SALEM PARKWAY PURSUANT TO SECTION 74-16 OF CITY CODE

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT) received a street mural application from the Winston-Salem Public Art Commission on behalf of Tamika Wells for the installation of the poem, "What if I Write?"; and

WHEREAS, this piece by Tamika Wells was selected by the Public Art Commission following the 2023 open public art call; and

WHEREAS, the application received for this mural indicates the text of the poem would be painted on the Strollway between First Street and Salem Parkway; and

WHEREAS, staff representing the Public Art Commission submitted the necessary application and supporting documentation for painting within the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the WSDOT has reviewed the application and installation methods for the proposed street mural; and

WHEREAS, the proposed mural meets the requirements of Section 74-16 of City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon the recommendation of the Public Works Committee, do hereby authorize the City of Winston-Salem Human Relations/Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Department or its designee to install a street mural on Trade Street per the submitted application.
