## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF PUBLIC SAFETY CAMERAS AND INSTALLATION SERVICES

**WHEREAS,** City Council approved on January 3, 2022, a contract with Call24 Security (Call24) for the support of the City's existing public safety security camera equipment, site evaluations, system design, and the installation of new cameras; and

**WHEREAS,** the services include the installation of equipment and the configuration of software, network, and video recording equipment; and

**WHEREAS,** the contract also provides the option for the City to purchase new security cameras and equipment from Call24 at fixed costs for the duration of the contract term; and

**WHEREAS,** the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the contract required vendors to provide hourly rates for onsite support services and pricing for twelve different types of cameras; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial price for the first year of the security camera support contract with Call24 was \$22,500, and was based solely on the onsite support of existing cameras; and

WHEREAS, an Addendum has been executed to increase the total contract amount to \$90,000 to cover the purchase and installation of new cameras at the Carl H. Russell Community Center, the Benton South Gallery Ballroom and Conference Rooms, and other projects; and

**WHEREAS,** in May 2022 City Council approved a request for the purchase of public safety cameras and installation services at a cost up to and not to exceed \$600,000; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff currently manage over 500 security cameras installed at 28 different City facilities, with over 200 of these security cameras having been added since the approval to spend \$600,000 with Call24 in May 2022; and

WHEREAS, staff has received requests to expand the

public safety security camera platform to 33 new sites; and

**WHEREAS**, funding has been allocated and is available for these new sites but proceeding requires Council approval of expenditure; and

**WHEREAS,** staff work plans are for many of these new cameras to be installed within the next 18 months, with the total pricing estimate for the projects being \$900,000; and

**WHEREAS,** funding to cover the projects is available in a combination of the 2018 Bonds

Project budget and in the I.S. operating and capital budgets; and

**WHEREAS,** staff is requesting approval to purchase public safety cameras and installation services at a cost up to and not to exceed \$900,000; and

**WHEREAS,** staff will leverage the flexibility and locked-in pricing of the contract with Call24 for many of these purchases; and

**WHEREAS,** while the Call24 pricing is an option, the City is not obligated to purchase equipment and services from Call24, and with rising equipment costs and supply-chain issues impacting the market, staff will obtain bids from other vendors as warranted; and

**WHEREAS,** staff will bring an item to Council for approval should the purchases with any other vendor approach \$100,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize the City Manager to approve purchase requests from staff for public safety cameras and installation services at a cost up to and not to exceed \$900,000.
