**Summary of Information:**

In accordance with the City of Winston-Salem’s Traffic Calming Policy, approved by the City Council in 2003 and modified in 2016, representatives of Heitman Drive formed a Traffic Calming Task Force and submitted a petition for traffic calming. The traffic calming plan calls for speed cushions placed at regular intervals along the roadway. The Heitman Drive residents have completed all the required steps outlined in the policy, therefore, the Department of Transportation recommends approval and construction of the plan at a cost of \$10,000. The plan is attached.
