## RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR OFF-ROAD DIESEL FUEL

**WHEREAS**, the Winston-Salem Fleet Department provides daily deliveries to locations across the City to fill off road equipment and the department maintains a Fuel Tanker Truck for this service and has regular requirements to purchase Off-Road Diesel Fuel; and

**WHEREAS**, after due advertisement, bids were accepted by the Purchasing Department at 10:00 a.m. on May 4, 2022, for the purchase of Off-Road Diesel Fuel through August 31, 2023, based on an estimated annual quantity of 104,000 gallons; and the following bids were received:

**WHEREAS,** historical spending information for the purchase of Off-Road Diesel Fuel was \$429,719.97 in FY2020, \$303,568.56 in FY2021, and \$421,970.70 in FY2022; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a contract be awarded to Quality Oil Co., LLC in the estimated amount of \$390,000.00 for the purchase of Off Road Diesel Fuel through August 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, bid terms allow the contract to be extended annually if the successful bidder is willing to extend the same or better pricing, if both parties agree, and funds are available for this purpose; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that a contract is hereby awarded to Quality Oil Co., LLC. In the estimated amount of \$390,000.00 for the purchase of Off-Road Diesel Fuel through August 31, 2023, based on historical spending data provided for the purchase of Off-Road Diesel Fuel.
