Summary of Information:

The owner of HyLyfe, LLC has made an application to operate a trolley service in the City of Winston-Salem. The applicant has provided documentation showing their capabilities to meet the financial requirements and the applicants have no outstanding debt with the City.

Based on a staff review of the application submitted by the company listed above, it is recommended that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be issued. Currently, HyLyfe, LLC is operating under a Temporary Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and staff has received no complaints regarding the service provided.
