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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT OF AD HOC  
MEMBERS TO THE CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, in March, Mayor Joines, along with representatives from United Way, The Winston-Salem Foundation, and Forsyth County, announced the creation of the COVID-19 Response Fund for Forsyth County; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 6, 2020, the City Council approved a \$1 million contribution to the fund, using 2014 and 2018 voter-approved economic development bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, in the days following the Council's approval, there were concerns expressed by some Council Members that the City's funds would not reach the local agencies that could impact those in the community with the greatest need; and

**WHEREAS**, at the direction of the Mayor and Council, City staff have developed a new process in which the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee would review applications submitted through the response fund's application portal and award one-time grants to local agencies that meet the Council's criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the committee members, the Mayor informally appointed three ad hoc grassroots members to participate in the committee's review process and provide input; and

**WHEREAS**, the ad hoc members are James Perry, Morticia "Tee-Tee" Parmon, and Corey McCann; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure the ad hoc members can participate fully in the review process, including voting on the award of grants, the Mayor and City Council seek to authorize the temporary appointment of ad hoc members to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to

participate in the City's review process to distribute the City's \$1 million contribution to the COVID-19 Response Fund for Forsyth County; and

**WHEREAS**, the ad hoc members will serve until the committee has distributed the entire \$1 million contribution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize the temporary appointment of ad hoc members to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to participate in the City's review process to distribute the City's \$1 million contribution to the COVID-19 Response Fund for Forsyth County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the following individuals will be appointed as ad hoc members of the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee: James Perry, Morticia "Tee-Tee" Parmon, and Corey McCann.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the ad hoc members will participate fully in the review process, including voting on the award of grants, and will serve until the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee has distributed the entire \$1 million contribution from the City.
