**RESOLUTION FIXING DATE FOR THE HEARING
ON A PETITION TO CLOSE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF FLATROCK
STREET AND NOTICE TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN THE CLOSING
THEREOF**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM that, in response to a petition filed with the City, a Public Hearing will be held on August 5th, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber on the Second Floor of City Hall to consider closing and abandoning a portion of Flatrock Street, as provided by N.C.G.S. §160A-299. All persons interested in the proposed closing are hereby notified to appear at this hearing and present their views to the Council. The area proposed to be closed is described as:

Beginning at a point on the eastern property line of Tax PIN 6844-59-4417 and the western right-of-way of Flatrock Street, thence north, with the eastern property line of Tax PIN 6844-59-4417, 335' to a point at the southeast corner of Tax PIN 6844-59-1810; thence north, 256' to a point on the southern property line of Tax PIN 6845-50-7451; thence east, 40' to a point at the northwest corner of Tax PIN 6844-59-7506; thence south, 581' to a point on the western property line of Tax PIN 6844-59-7506; thence west, 40' to the point and place of Beginning.
