RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING UPDATED LOCATION FOR UNITED HEALTH CENTERS TRANFORMATIONAL GRANT-FUNDED FACILITY

WHEREAS, The City of Winston-Salem received \$51.7 million through the American Rescue Plan Act's (ARPA) Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CLFRF) from the U.S. Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved \$10,500,000 of ARPA CLFRF Revenue Replacement funding for social and economic assistance through Transformational Grants; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved a resolution, on January 3, 2023, for United Health Centers authorizing funding in the amount of \$500,000 to up fit a new facility to provide access to high-quality, culturally competent healthcare services, aimed to positively impact the physical and economic viability of underserved residents living in the areas surrounding the Northwest Boulevard and Liberty Street neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, an amended grant application was received by City Staff requesting the above stated Northwest Boulevard and Liberty Street location be amended to the Southeast Plaza Shopping Center area; and

WHEREAS, this amended application was received in November 2022, and the older location was not intended to be part of the original resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that funding previously appropriated for the United Health Centers Transformational Grant may be used in the Waughtown Street and Kernersville Road areas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other original language related to the scope of the project remains intact, and that any funding related to this transformational grant must be used for operating or capital needs related to the upfit or construction of a new health care facility.
