Resolution Approving Changes in the State Highway Secondary Road System Within the Existing Corporate Limits of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina (East Ward)

Periodically, the City and the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) staff review streets located within the corporate limits of the City of Winston-Salem to determine if any streets should be changed from the NCDOT system to the City system or changed from the City system to the NCDOT system. A resolution approving these changes is needed from the City Council to add a street segment to the City system for annual maintenance. The changes reflected in this resolution include:

1. adding 0.72 mi of Research Parkway to be transferred from the NCDOT system to the City System.

In 2010, the City entered into an agreement with NCDOT and the Piedmont Triad Research Park (PTRP) for the construction and funding of Research Parkway from Rams Drive to Third Street. This street segment has been constructed per NCDOT specifications and the warranty period has now expired. Due to the use of federal funds, this street segment has been listed on the State highway system since constructed. However, per the 2010 agreement, Research Parkway will be owned and maintained by the City of Winston-Salem. On November 5th, 2020, the North Carolina Board of Transportation approved the deletion of this street segment from the State Highway System. This council action request will formalize the acceptance of this street segment and set the acceptance date for the annual Powell Bill reporting. The description and limits for this street segment are attached.
