Summary of Information:

City/County Purchasing advertised a bid for resurfacing city streets and bids were scheduled to be received on April 11, 2024, with bidding subsequently extended to April 18. However, fewer than three bids were offered as required by North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) 143-132(a). Therefore, in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-129, the project was re-advertised. Bids were received April 25, 2024, with a summary of bids as follows:

APAC-Atlantic, Inc., Thompson-Arthur Division	Greensboro, NC	\$9,890,146.45

APAC-Atlantic, Inc., Thompson-Arthur Division, submitted subcontracting goals of 5.06% to certified minority-owned businesses and 5.45% to certified woman-owned businesses, which exceeded those established for this project of 5% MBE and 5% WBE. Therefore, it is recommended that a contract be awarded to APAC-Atlantic, Inc., Thompson-Arthur Division, the low bidder meeting specifications, in the estimated total amount of \$9,890,146.45.

The bid price exceeds the available funds of \$9,833,700; therefore, additional funds will be made available through appropriated Powell Bill reserves to cover the full contract amount and any contingencies that may arise.
