**WHEREAS**, it is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Modern Chevrolet of Winston-Salem, NC for the purchase of two one-ton pickup trucks with utility bodies and traffic signs, per bid specifications, in the amount of \$112,523.00 each for a total cost of \$225,046.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, and upon approval by the Finance Committee, that a purchase order is hereby awarded to Modern Chevrolet for the purchase of two 2024 Chevrolet 3500 trucks with utility bodies and traffic signs per bid specification in the amount of \$112,523.00 each for a total cost of \$225,046.00.
