

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM TO APPLY FOR A  
FY 2018 U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR YOUTHBUILD GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Labor has announced the availability of \$85 million in grant funding to continue or expand YouthBuild programs nationwide; and

**WHEREAS**, YouthBuild is a community-based alternative education program that provides classroom instruction and occupational skills training in construction and other in-demand occupations to at-risk youth and young adults ages 16-24, and requires participants to earn a high school diploma or G.E.D; and

**WHEREAS**, in-demand tracks of healthcare, transportation and logistics, advanced manufacturing, and aviation will be offered in addition to construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2018 YouthBuild Grant has a 25% non-federal matching fund requirement totaling \$275,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for a FY 2018 U.S. Department of Labor YouthBuild Grant in the amount of \$1.1 million and to execute agreements and documents necessary to implement the grant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and City Council that the City Manager is authorized to use Housing Finance Funds for only housing/construction related programs with the remaining match to be provided by other local funding sources and in-kind services for the non-federal local matching fund grant requirement.
