Summary of Information:

Annually, the State of North Carolina issues a Request for Proposals for Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) funds for programs that serve homeless persons. The City of Winston-Salem serves as the Collaborative Applicant for the Continuum of Care in Winston-Salem and Forsyth County and is conducting the process to obtain State ESG funds on behalf of local agencies for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY 2023). The application process for local agencies to apply for State ESG funds was included as part of the Community Agency FY 2023-2024 Request for Funding.

Funding recommendations, as shown in Exhibit A, were developed by the Continuum of Care Rating Panel and reviewed by the Continuum of Care Operating Cabinet and the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Commission on Ending Homelessness. The State’s Request for Proposals is expected to be issued in June 2023. The application typically is due within 45

days of issue of the Request for Proposals. The State may contract directly with local agencies or with the City to pass through funds to local agencies.

The accompanying resolution authorizes the City Manager to apply for State ESG funds, execute grant agreements with the State, execute subgrantee agreements with approved project agencies, and execute and submit required technical documentation and periodic progress reports to the State.
