Resolution Awarding Purchase Order for Side-Loading and Rear-Loading Refuse Trucks

Summary of Information:

The Curbside and Yard Waste Divisions of the Sanitation Department budgeted to replace two side-loading refuse trucks and one rear-loading refuse truck that have exceeded Fleet's replacement criteria. See Exhibit A for replacement information.

On December 6, 2019, Sourcewell, a cooperative purchasing group located in Staples, Minnesota, awarded contracts for mobile refuse collection vehicles and The Heil Company (Chattanooga, TN) was awarded competitive bid contract #091219-THC per bid specifications. Carolina Environmental Systems, Inc. (Greensboro, NC) is the sole Heil distributor for North Carolina and has offered quotations for two side-loading refuse trucks at a cost of \$369,989 each and one rear-loading refuse truck at a cost of \$256,596, with standard options selected by the City, for a total cost of \$996,574.

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies."

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Carolina Environmental Systems, Inc., per Sourcewell contract #091219-THC, for two side-loading refuse trucks at a cost of \$369,989 each and one rear-loading refuse truck at a cost of \$256,596 for a total cost of \$996,574. These recommendations are in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3).
