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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A. MORTON THOMAS AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING, AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE MULTI-USE PATH (EASTERN SECTION) ALONG SALEM PARKWAY

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT) solicited proposals to provide Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services for the Multi-Use Path construction project that was awarded in February; and

WHEREAS, based on the qualifications received, WSDOT is recommending that A. Morton Thomas and Associates, Inc. be awarded the CEI contract to aid in the construction management, materials testing, and inspection of the eastern section of the Multi-Use Path; and

WHEREAS, firms were asked to provide a proposal that would include construction project management, inspection of project elements including the pedestrian bridge, and coordination with key project stakeholders; and

WHEREAS, a selection committee consisting of city staff from various departments evaluated the proposals based on M/WBE commitment, staff experience and availability, work experience, understanding of project, and past performance; and

WHEREAS, based on the proposals that were received, A. Morton Thomas and Associates, Inc. tied for the highest score with Summit Design and Engineering Services, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, both aforementioned firms were asked to provide a scope and fee for this work; and

WHEREAS, A. Morton Thomas and Associates, Inc. offered a lower price for their services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with A. Morton
