the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, to close a portion of S. Main Street and Hilton Drive,

as described on the next page; and

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of June 2024, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the

City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, a resolution fixing the date and hour for the hearing on

said petition was adopted by unanimous vote of said City Council; and the date and hour were

fixed on the 5th day of August 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, Second Floor of City

Hall in the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, notice of said meeting was published once a week for four successive weeks

in the Winston-Salem Journal, a newspaper published in the City of Winston-Salem, North

above-described petition and notice of the closing and public hearing was posted in at least two

prominent places along said portions of said street proposed to be closed; and

Carolina, that the closing of the indicated portion of said S. Main Street and Hilton Drive is not

contrary to the public interest and that no other individual owning property adjoining, abutting or

in the vicinity of said right-of-way will thereby be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and

egress to his property.

S. Main Street & Hilton Drive; thence west, S88°35'33"W 85.28' to a point at the

southeast corner of Tax PIN 6833-24-2909; thence northeast, with the property line of Tax PIN 6833-24-2909, N59°39'27"E 109.97' to a point; thence northeast,

N31°31'38"E 20.44' to the point and place of Beginning.

is hereby ordered closed, subject to the City of Winston-Salem's reservation of all of its rights,

titles, and interests in any public utility, drainage, landscaping, and the City of Winston-Salem's

reservation of an easement in the entire area hereinabove described for the construction, inspection,

operation, maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, reconstruction, replacement, and expansion of

landscaping, and all public utilities located therein, or to be located therein, including water, sewer

and storm drainage lines and facilities.
