Zoning Petition of Village at Robinhood, LLC, Docket W-3411

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WINSTON-SALEM CITY ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM, N.C.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

Section 1. The Winston-Salem City Zoning Ordinance and the Official Zoning Map of the City of Winston-Salem, N.C. are hereby amended by changing from MU-S to GB-S (Arts and Crafts Studio; Banking and Financial Services; Car Wash; Club or Lodge; Combined Use; Convenience Store; Food or Drug Store; Furniture and Home Furnishings Store; Government Offices, Neighborhood Organization, or Post Office; Library, Public; Museum or Art Gallery; Nursery, Lawn and Garden Supply Store, Retail; Offices; Police or Fire Station; Recreation Services, Indoor; Recreation Services, Outdoor; Restaurant (with drive-through Service); Restaurant (without drive-through Service); Retail Store; School, Vocational or Professional; Services, A; Storage Services, Retail; Swimming Pool, Private; Testing and Research Lab; Theater, Indoor; Utilities; Veterinary Services; Child Day Care Center; Residential Building, Multifamily; Residential Building, Townhouse; Residential Building, Twin Home; and Residential Building, Duplex) the zoning classification of the following described property:

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance is adopted after approval of the site plan entitled <u>Robinhood Village</u> and identified as Attachment "A" of the Special Use District Permit issued by the City Council the <u>3rd</u> day of <u>June</u>, 20<u>19</u> to <u>Village at Robinhood</u>, <u>LLC</u>.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City Council hereby directs the issuance of a Special Use District Permit pursuant to the Zoning Ordinance of the *Unified Development Ordinances* for a development to be known as <u>Robinhood Village</u>. Said Special Use District Permit and site plan with associated documents are attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.
