Consideration of a Petition to Close and Abandon a Portion of Eleventh Street and Ivy Avenue (East Ward) – Petition of David Vogel/Two Cities Church, Inc., represented by Luke Dickey, Stimmel Associates, P.A.

**Summary of Information:**

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from Luke Dickey to close and abandon a portion of Eleventh Street and Ivy Avenue. The areas petitioned for closure are:

- 1.) An unimproved portion of Eleventh Street and an adjacent unnamed alley. It is bounded on the north by Tax PIN's 6836-30-2570, 6836-30-3517, and 6836-30-4736, on the east by Tax Pin 6836-30-4736 and on the south by Tax Pin's 6836-30-5440, and 6836-30-3317.
  
- 2.) An unnamed alley approximately 146' in length and has a width varying from 10' to 16'. It is bounded on the north and west by Tax PIN 6836-30-4736, and on the south by Tax Pin's 6836-30-5485, 6836-30-6435, and 6836-30-6484.

The Public Works Department has reviewed the requests. There are no Planning or WSDOT concerns if these rights-of-way are closed. There are public utilities located in both rights-of-way, the City would need to retain easements. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.
