On behalf of the City of Winston-Salem and in coordination with the office of Council Member Barbara H. Burke, Planning staff was directed to conduct the required neighborhood outreach meeting with any concerned citizens regarding this rezoning request.

The attached neighborhood outreach letter was sent to all property owners within 500 feet of the subject property along with a location map and a list of uses currently allowed in the Limited Industrial (LI) zoning district.

An in-person neighborhood outreach was held at the Mazie Woodruff Center on December 5, 2023, from 5:30 PM-6:30 PM with Council Member Burke, Community Assistance Liaison Tamra Bradshaw-Sheller, Planning & Development Services Director Chris Murphy, and Principal Planner Bryan D. Wilson in attendance.

A brief presentation by Council Member Burke and Chris Murphy was followed by an informal question and answer session with eleven (11) citizens present. General questions regarding what the rezoning entailed, including the requested uses, were answered by both Council Member Burke and Chris Murphy. Council Member Burke also answered questions about the possibility of affordable housing at the site. Additionally, Council Member Burke responded to public inquiry about the possible future uses unrelated to the request.

Other questions were asked by citizens about how the property would be accessed. Chris Murphy responded that the most likely access point would be from Motor Road.

In summary, those present were generally accepting of this rezoning request and the meeting was adjourned. Please see the attached copy of the neighborhood outreach letter and attendance sheet.


